



Focus on 1-3 Goals

- Keep goals simple and realistic *cheat CODE: NUAMES has the same goals for all grants, plans & reports. Once we have met the goal the goal becomes imbedded culture, we adjust the sails and go after the next one.
- TRACK THE DATA (& be honest about what that data says)
- Make decisions based on what is best for student learning, not what is convenient for those who work at the school



Example: NUAMES Mathematics

Goal: Reduce the non-pass rate in **Sec 2** by 10% annually



Goal: Reduce the non-pass rate in Sec 2 by 10% annually

- 1. Lowered class sizes in Sec 2
- 2. Added a **Sec 2 Essentials** course (math every day)

3. D/F Blitz

- a. 2-5 min conversation w/ student how the school can support the student in being successful
- b. Plan created if need two week tracking of student performance
- c. We care and we are here to help you find success



Goal: Reduce the non-pass rate in **Sec 2** by 10% annually **YEAR #2**:

- 1. Established a common language & repeat exposure opportunities
 - a. Dove into the curriculum, analyzed each lesson & each test question
 - b. Created formula sheets for math, chem, physics & engineering
 - c. Common phrasing
- 2. In reading course we add 100 most used words in math, science and engineering as part of the curriculum
- 3. Reevaluated what did we get right? Where can we improve?



Mentorship/Capstone Program - Every student is assign a mentor in 10th grade - stays with that cohort for 3 years - each student completes a capstone project.



- Math Boot Camp
 - o 2 weeks/ m-th 2 hrs

 - reduce anxiety

- D.E.N meet with local school district & other charter schools in the area quarterly

NUAMES Effective Practices

- Low counselor to student ratio
- Small class size, small school size
- We allow students to take 1 course away from NUAMES
- Provide bus passes for students
- ACT Boot Camps
- Parent Nights
